

SNS REJUVENATION SIG – SPRING UPDATE

The SNS Rejuvenation SIG met on 19th April 2018 to discuss the previous actions and to look at how the group has been progressing. Thank you to Perenco for hosting the meeting at their offices.

Nick Ford has been instructed as the Tight Gas Workgroup's new chairperson since Kathy Heller has stepped down from her role. The Fracipedia data collection has been agreed and will be collected by operators via the OGA.

The UK/NL Best Practise Workgroup had no new activity to update.

The Synergies between Renewables and E&P Workgroup met on 16th May during EEEGR's SNS 2018 event. The group discussed their three main workstreams; coexistence, common standards and gas to wire/power to gas to determine a plan of action. Co-leads for each of the three groups have been confirmed.

Philippa Warren of EEEGR gave an update on the Salting workgroup. Philippa discussed the group's wishes to publish a salting document which will outline the state of the SNS and what salting is. A quote was received with regards to the document and the group are now waiting for a decision on whether to move forward with the document.

The SIG is currently investigating a new chairperson. Thanks to Fraser Weir for all his hard work with this group to date.
